


The Delta is Europe's largest remaining natural wetland - a unique ecosystem






RURAL DEPOPULATION, URBAN EXPANSION

- 2020: 4 of 5 Europeans live in urban areas
- 18-25 million hectares left aside until 2035 (IEEP, 2010)
- Main drivers: young people leaving, marginal economy (subsidies)
- Huge socio-economic impacts and cultural losses
- This changes the relationship between man and nature – both rural and urban













Communities GDP: up to 90% comes from agriculture and natural capital (16 % of community land) is of no value





New opportunities for tourism development for agricultural communities: Launch year 1500 visitors





2021: 7000 visitors for cultural tourism and wildlife

Nature-based solution to Katlabuh Lake - one of the largest lakes in the Danube delta.

2019: 280k USD spent to solve urgent water crisis
